

Pool Manager

The City of Thompson invites qualified applicants for the position of Pool Manager.

The successful candidate will organize the day to day supervision of the Norplex Pool, supporting the programs and staff, ensuring safe and efficient use of the pool facility while promoting a high standard of health and safety and customer care. This executive position reports to the Director of Recreation, Parks and Culture.

The incumbent shall possess superior communication skills (both written and verbal), excellent organizational skills and problem-solving skills, be detailed oriented and have the ability to exercise good judgement at all times. The Manager will require working knowledge of various computer programs, including Microsoft Office, program scheduling software, and accounting software.

The Manager will have demonstrated experience in budgeting, managing and motivating in a Unionized environment, reviewing, interpreting and applying applicable legislation, coordinating programs or events, and promotion and advertising. Preferred qualifications include: Pool Operations Management education, post-secondary education in Recreation, Facility Management, Aquatic Facility Management or Aquatic Supervisor training and certification, as well as current certification as National Lifeguard Instructor and Instructor Trainer and previous demonstrated experience in delivering the LSS Swim for Life, Bronze Star, Bronze Medallion, Bronze Cross and Standard First Aid / CPR courses and programs. The City will consider a minimum of 3 years of related Supervisory experience or an equivalent combination of education and experience.
