- Travel to diverse rural Manitoba communities.
- Submit weekly reports and administrative paperwork to the Program Coordinator.

- Criminal Record Check & Child Abuse Registry/Vulnerable Persons Registry Check
- Previous experience as a swimming/lifesaving instructor
- Ability to work alone, with a colleague, and/or with minimal supervision
- Openness and willingness to work with various cultures
- Ability and willingness to travel to rural locations
