The Lord Selkirk School Division is looking for Lifeguards (NLS), Lifesaving Swim for Life Instructors and Lifesaving Instructors (LSI) for the upcoming 2022- 2023. Under the direction of the Pool Manager, staff will be responsible to provide public safety to patrons, ensure the facility is maintained to standard, handling payments and instruct swimming lessons and water safety programs.

This casual position involves evening and Saturday shifts. Applications will be accepted until all the positions are filled. Applicants must include copies of the minimum requirements listed below with their application. All applicants must be available for training.

Qualifications:

- Minimum 16 years of age.
- Current Standard First and CPR-C as outlined by Manitoba Public Health guidelines. (See below)
- National lifeguard certification (NLS).
- ***Red Cross Water Safety Instructor Certificate (must complete transfer to Swim for Life Instructor by December 31, 2022.***
- Swim for Life Instructor Certificate.
- Lifesaving Society Instructor (considered an asset).
- National Lifeguard Instructor (considered an asset).
- Must be physically able to perform all responsibilities and other duties as assigned for the position.
- Clear current Child Abuse Registry.
- Clear current Criminal Record Check.

Manitoba Public Health guidelines:

- 12(2) No person shall be a lifeguard unless he or she (a) is 16 years of age or older;
(b) holds a current Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation Certificate of C-Level or higher, in accordance with the standards set by the International Liaison Committee on Resuscitation;
(c) holds one of the following:
(i) St. John Ambulance Standard First Aid Certificate,
